

Introduction


This guide will show how to connect to the Eduroam wireless network when you are having trouble connecting.

Certificate Installation

1. Open the settings tray from the bottom right-hand toolbar.
2. Select the network icon.




3. Select the “eduroam-onboarding” network.




4. Open Google Chrome and navigate to cat.eduroam.org


5. Scroll down on the webpage and select the link to download the eduroam installer.




6. Select "Southern Connecticut State University" from the list.




7. Select the "eduroam" button.




- Take note of the instructions that appear below. These instructions will be needed to complete the process:



- Select "Continue".
- Once you receive the notice that the file has downloaded, in Google Chrome navigate to: <chrome://network>
- Scroll down and select "Choose File" under "Import ONC File".




12. Select the ONC file named “eduroam-chromeos-SCSU-Production” from your Downloads.




Join Wi-Fi


1. Select the Settings tray.



2. Select the “eduroam” network. Confirm it is not “eduroam-onboarding”.




3. Ensure you have the proper settings. On ChromeOS they are as follows: For the “EAP Method” field select “PEAP”
4. For the “EAP Phase 2 authentication” field select “MSCHAPv2”
5. For the “Server CA certificate” field, select “Do no check”



6. Remove any text within the “Anonymous Identity” field if there is any.

7. For the “identity” Field enter your full SCSU email. For the “Password” field enter the password for your email.



8. Confirm all the fields are entered correctly then select “Connect”.
9. Return to your settings tray to verify you are connected. It will look like the image below when connected.
